

## Darr and Fairview Boundary Descriptions

### Darr Elementary:

The northern boundary is in the area just south of Wallis Road. It includes the Woodhaven sub-division north of Stratsman Lane including all residences on Mount Hebron south of Woodhaven to Monroe Avenue. The boundary then extend eastward off of Mount Hebron to include all area south of Garrett Road up to Creekwood sub-division. Boundary goes southward to include all of Cross Creek sub-division. Boundary line then goes back westward to an imaginary straight line extended from the north-south portion of Zion Church Road. The boundary continues southward along Zion Church Road until it reaches Monroe Avenue (Highway 264). Boundary continues westward on Monroe Avenue all the way to the western RPS boundary line and includes several areas south of Monroe Avenue. The western boundary line includes Ford Lane and Rainbow Road to Shores Avenue. At Shores Avenue, the western boundary becomes an area just west of Mount Hebron Road including the Ivy's Phase I and Woodhaven subdivisions.

### Fairview Boundary:

The northern boundary line is West Drive with imaginary lines extending westward just east of Mount Hebron Road and eastward to I-49. The northern boundary turns southward and stays on the west side of I-49 until Oakwood Avenue. At Oakwood Avenue, the boundary goes eastward across I-49 and includes all residences on Oakwood Avenue. Oakwood Avenue turns southward and becomes Robinson Avenue as it turns back eastward. Robinson then becomes the northern boundary to Business 71. The southern boundary would be the southern portion of RPS boundaries from Business 71 to an imaginary line extending southward from Ford Lane which establishes the western boundary.
