

# STIN ASSISTANCE

State Teacher Identification Number (STIN) reports are sent to each building principal containing STINs, but in some cases an educator's STIN will not appear. This usually happens when the position is not directly tied to the APSCN teacher catalog, such as administration positions, etc.

If an individual State Teacher Identification Number (STIN) does not appear in the current report educators can request assistance from AETN by email or phone.
