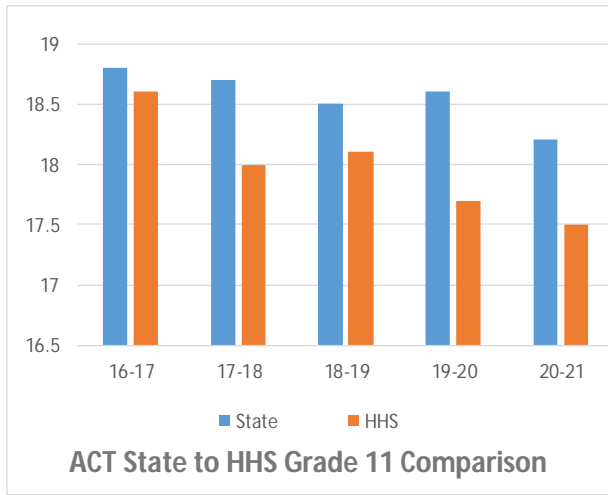

In 2021-2022 school year, HHS Seniors were accepted to over 100 different colleges including the University of Arkansas, Harding, Brown, Notre Dame, Rochester Technical Institute, Pepperdine University, Northwestern, and many entering various branches of military, which include the Arkansas National Guard and the Navy.
